Child Abuse Prevention Month

479 Pinwheels = 479 Children Who Need Your Help

April marked the beginning of Child Abuse Prevention Month, which is a national initiative that raises awareness about child abuse and how to prevent it from happening. Advocates for Children, along with community partner, Harbin Clinic, raised awareness during the month of April. For the second year in a row, Harbin Clinic joined us in this campaign to help assure that children have the positive childhoods that every child deserves.

In 2021, Advocates for Children conduced 479 forensic interviews for children who made allegations of physical and/or sexual abuse and neglect. This is almost a 25% increase from interviews done in the previous year.

Not only did Harbin Clinic plant their own pinwheels for prevention at multiple locations, but they also hosted a hugely successful diaper drive that was then donated to our Hope in Your Home families. Diapers, wipes, pull ups, and other infant and toddler care items were distributed to our families in need thanks to the team at Harbin.


