# What is Duck Derby?

Advocates for Children hosts Duck Derby annually; this year we're celebrating 21 years of ducks! The Duck Derby is a really Quacky concept. Ducks are sold in various packages ranging from \$5-\$250.



Duck adoptions (entries) for our duck race are sold to friends, family members and businesses and one the lucky duck winner will receive \$10,000! The adoptions/ race entries are sold in various packages, ranging from \$5 to \$250. The duck race will take place on May 13 at 2 p.m. and the lucky duck winner will be announced that day!

\*\*Winners do not have to be present to win. Must be 18 or older to receive the cash award



## Who Wins Duck Derby?

On the day of the big event, 20,000 ducks will race and one lucky ducky will cross the finish line in the Etowah River and be declared the winner. The duck who finishes first will be the grand prize winner and take home the \$10,000 prize.


# What is

# What Makes Duck Derby 2023 so Special?

## Quacky Cash Rules

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- High School Senior and scheduled to graduate in May 2023
- Live in Bartow County
- Parent/Guardian must sign consent for students to participate

#### **Special Contest Rules:**

- Sell a minimum of 500 ducks to be eligible for any cash prize
- Be willing to turn in adoption papers weekly
