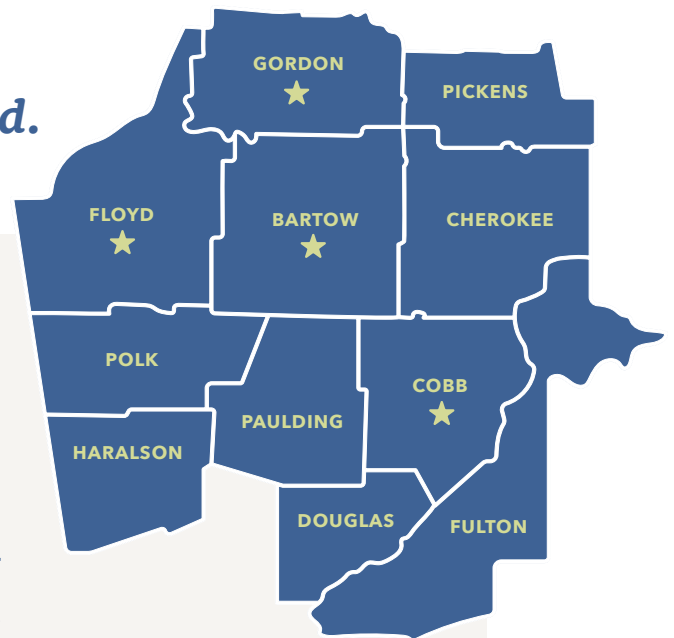

FOSTERING SUCCESS ACT TAX CREDIT

Businesses in Georgia now have the chance to re-direct state tax dollars to donate to Advocates for Children and receive a tax credit from the state. Georgia is providing this tax credit to support programs serving youth in foster care and young adults in transitional care, helping them secure housing, build life skills, gain employment and solidify their path to independence.
